- Viewing and updating personal student details, including medical conditions and address
- Enrolment details
- Upcoming events list showing school events.

QParents will assist both staff and parents in sharing and responding to information in an efficient and effective way.

QParent invites have been regularly emailed home to parents (please check your inboxes). You will also need your student's 10 digit EQ ID. This can be found on previous report card emails which you have received or by contacting our administration team who will happily supply you with your child's unique number.



SCHOOL UNIFORM FOR 2024

The end of year is approaching and that often means that students will require new uniforms and shoes. At Mountain Creek State School the expectation is that each day students will wear one of the agreed Mountain Creek State School uniforms as outlined below. To cater for all students the uniform consists of a variety of items that can be mixed and matched along with unisex items that ALL students can choose to wear.

UNIFORM OPTIONS:

- MCSS Polo Year P-6
- MCSS Dress Years P − 6
- MCSS Navy Skorts P − 6
- MCSS Navy Shorts P 6

OTHER:

- Plain black shoes (no colours)
- Plain black or navy ankle socks (visible above shoe)
- MCSS broadbrim hat (caps are not permitted)

Should students wear plain navy alternatives purchased elsewhere then the following considerations are to be adhered to:

- Shorts, skorts and skirts must be at a minimum mid-thigh in length
- NO open side splits are to be above mid-thigh height

JEWELLERY:

- Students are permitted to wear only the following items:
- An analogue or digital watch
- One/two small plain stud or small plain sleeper of silver, gold or neutral in colour in the lower lobe of each ear
- Medical alert bracelets
- Religious or culturally significant pendants e.g. signet rings, tiki or crucifix by written request of parent

STUDENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO WEAR THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- Smartwatches
- Necklaces, bracelets and rings (these are considered a safety hazard and could come in contact with another student causing injury to self or others)

HAIR:

To reduce the transfer of head lice as well as to avoid distractions to learning, hair that is at or longer than shoulder length is to be plaited, braided or tied back with long fringes pinned back from eyes. To ensure hairstyles are not a distraction to teaching and learning hair accessories are to be neutral in colour or MCSS uniform school colours (white or navy). The length of the fringe should not exceed the eyebrows so as not to impede learning or pose a safety risk.

MAKEUP AND NAIL POLISH:

No makeup is to be worn to school. Coloured nail polish is not acceptable. Students wearing coloured nail polish will be asked to remove it immediately. Nail polish remover will be provided.

The students will be completing a small obstacle course which will have a couple of sprinkler stations set up, along with the Fire Service, for the students to get wet so that the colours will stay on their shirts.

All children are expected to participate unless they have a medical condition which would put them at risk when running. If students are not participating in the Colour Run please ensure that you have a signed note from parents detailing why.

The dress code for the day shall be:

COLOUR RUN - WHITE SHIRT*, shorts/skorts, running shoes and hat.

* If students do not have white shirts they can wear any old shirt to get coloured, however, white will provide the best effect.

Parents may also want to have an old towel for the car trip home as the students will be getting wet so that the colour will stay on their shirts.

COLOUR POWDER

The colour powder used in our event is made of high-quality corn starch and only permitted food colours. It is non-toxic, gluten-free, biodegradable, skin safe and environmentally friendly. Students with asthma are advised to be careful in their decision to participate.

COASTAL DISTRICT SCHOOL SPORT

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Mountain Creek SS is a member of 'Coastal District 10-12 Years School Sport'. Coastal District School Sport is the first level in the representative school sport program. After district representation, students then have the opportunity to progress to the regional trials and then onto the state championships.



The representative school sport pathway is offered to students born in 2012 (Under 12), 2013 (Under 11) and 2014 (Under 10).

To be eligible to participate in this program students must demonstrate a *very high level* of ability in their chosen sport. The representative pathway is *not* a participation or 'come & try' program. Students should be the top players in their club. (NB. Girls AFL and boys' and girls' softball all have a different criteria due to the limited club participation).

At the moment the Coastal District School Sport selection policy only allows a maximum of five (5) students from each school to attend at district trial. In the event that more than five students express their interest to attend a particular district trial, a school-based trial will be conducted to select the five most eligible school representatives.

The district trials will start in Term 1 Week 3 (5th February 2024). In January 2024 you will receive an email with an 'Expression of Interest Survey' for you to nominate your child's interest in the sport/s they wish to trial for and a copy of the trial dates.

2024 COASTAL DISTRICT SWIMMING TRIALS

Just a quick reminder about the 2024 Coastal District Swimming Trials for students born in 2014, 2013, 2012 (turning 10, 11 and 12 in 2024) which will be held on Friday 23rd February, 2024. Students who are wishing to trial in 2024 will need to nominate using times swum at our 2024 School Swimming Carnival (50m) or times from Swimming Australia – Results Central https://www.swimming.org.au/events/results-central (50m, 100m, 200m and 400m Freestyle and IM) only. All times from 'Swimming Australia – Results Central' must have been swum in a 50m (long course pool) and in the current swimming season (1 July 2023 to 19 February 2024 inclusive).

NO other times will be accepted. Events that you wish for your child to nominate in must have times submitted using the above method.

Early in Term 1 2024 more information will be sent out to interested students with all nomination forms attached.
